Guidelines for Submitting Dissertation

All the IInd Year students of M.A. (JMC) have to submit a dissertation on a topic related to any of

the papers prescribed in the previous or final year. It will be valued for 100 Marks. The purpose of the dissertation is to provide an experience to the student to apply his knowledge of research methodology on a topic of his/her choice related to the subject.

The student has to select a guide and select the topic with the assistance of the guide and complete the dissertation under his/her guidance.

Any working journalist of the cadre of Staff Reporter/Sub-Editor and above of a major Telugu or English news daily/Channel/teacher in journalism of any college/university is eligible to guide the candidates.

The dissertation should consist of a comprehensive study of any topic. It is advisable that the student also undertakes an empirical study in addition to the theoretical analysis of the topic. The dissertation may consist of about **50-60** computerized pages (7,500 to 9,000 words) in one and half lifes format in English or Telugu.

ADDITIONAL GUIDELINES RELATING TO SUBMISSION OF DISSERTATION OF MA (JMC):

ONE copy of the Dissertation should be submitted in **hard bound** (Spiral binding is not permitted) as per the schedule. If a candidate fails to submit dissertation within the stipuated time he/she will have to pay the late fee prescribed by the University authorities from time to time. The dissertations submitted after due date with fine will be sent for evaluation along with the dissertations of the subsequent examinations only. In any case dissertation has to be submitted witin the validity period of a candidate's registration.

Candidate should submit the dissertation with

- 1. Title page
- 2. Declaration Form
- 3. Certificate from the guide in the prescribed form given below.
- 4. Acknowledgements
- 5. Contents

The Hard copy of the dissertation are to be sent to **The Project Head, ANU-CDE-ICT-Division, International Students Cell, Acharya Nagarjuna University, Nagarjuna Nagar, Guntur, A.P.-522510** before the due date as communicated by the office. One hard copy of the dissertation is to be retained with the student.


